Nailstone Parish Council Grant awarding policy

- 1. Nailstone Parish Council may make small donations to organisations which directly benefit the local area or some or all of its inhabitants. To be eligible for a grant the organisation must be charitable or non profit-making and will be expected to report on how the grant has been spent.
- 2. Nailstone Parish Council may support local organisations in other ways, for example by providing facilities, equipment, logistical support, advertising, and helping with the recruitment of volunteers.
- 3. Nailstone Parish Council does not make grants to individuals.
- 4. Nailstone Parish Council does not make grants to national charities or relief funds on the grounds that it is a personal matter for parishioners to decide for themselves which if any charities to support. The Parish Council has no power to make donations to charities or funds which do not directly benefit residents of the United Kingdom.

This policy was adopted by Nailstone Parish Council at a meeting on 31st January 2024.
