- Application 19/01304 Veros Lane, Nailstone

- 672/2019. Council to agree temporary clerk contract of employment and scale rate

Scale 13 currently £11.45 (NJC rate)
It was agreed 5 hours per week.
Precept allowance for 2020-2021 £2860 (at £11.45 x52x5 hours weeks £2977
– shortfall covered by reserves but not all weeks will be 5 hours)
