Stoneshollow Solar Farm

The planning proposal has been given the address of Church Farm, Washpit Lane, Barlestone


Stoneshollow Solar Farm, situated between Nailstone and Barlestone - The planning application (21/01395 FUL) is now out for consultation. The deadline for your comments is **11TH MARCH 2022**.

The proposal is for

Installation and operation a of a renewable energy generating station comprising ground-mounted photovoltaic solar arrays and battery-based electricity storage containers together with substation, point of connection mast, switchgear container, inverter/transformer units, Site access, internal access tracks, security measures, access gates, other ancillary infrastructure and landscaping and biodiversity enhancements'.

The proposal is across approx. 103ha and includes the following elements:

- Solar photovoltaic (PV) panels, ground mounted onto a framework made of galvanized steel;
- String Combiner Boxes to combine multiple strings of PV panels;
- 20 No. Inverter/Transformer Units dispersed across the Site.
- 22 No. Battery Storage Units across 11 No. Battery Stations dispersed across the Site;
- 1 No. Customer Switchgear Container Unit;
- 2m high security fencing (deer fencing) with double wing gates to enclose the perimeters of the Site and allow sheep to graze securely;
- Security and monitoring CCTV/infra-red cameras mounted on poles along the Site perimeter;
- Underground and tray cabling to connect panels, inverters and batteries to the switchgear unit and underground cable connecting the main Solar Farm site to DNO infrastructure;
- 1 No. DNO 132kv Substation with Point of Connection (POC) masts;
- Landscaping planting, biodiversity enhancements
