TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER:-

WOOD ROAD, NAILSTONE

Leicestershire County Council Highways has agreed to a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order at the above location.

A road closure is required on Wood Road between the junction with Battram Road, Ellistown and the junction with Grange Lane, Nailstone on 17th and 18th June 2019 for overnight closures between 19:00 and 07:00.

The Temporary Traffic Regulation Order will be implemented for public safety for to facilitate new junction work and highway maintenance.

The proposed alternative diversion route will be via:- Battram; Victoria Road, Ellistown; West Lane, Stanton under Bardon; West Lane, Ellistown and Battleflat; Beveridge Lane, Bardon Road, Bardon (A511); Bardon Road, Stephenson Way, Coalville (A511); Swannington Road, Wash Lane, Ibstock Road, Ravenstone (A447); Melbourne Road, Snibston; Melbourne Road, Hinckley Road, Ibstock (A447); Grange Road, Nailstone and vice versa.
